Accessing the Assessment Participation Exemption Request form from the Parent Portal

This guide will show you how to excuse a student from participating in state/district assessments. *Caution:* Only the student's legal parent/guardian is authorized to excuse their child/children from participating in state/district assessments.

Follow the steps below to exempt a student from participating in state/district assessments.
