







3. Hagan clic en **Formulario de no participación en la evaluación** en el menú de opciones de esta página.



We believe that assessments provide valuable information for parents and students on where students stand on the mastery of the standards, and whether or not they are on track to graduate, prepared for the 21st century. Assessments help us ensure that every child receives an equitable education and is on the path to success. It is a disadvantage for you and your child to lose access to such important information.




